CAM International, originally constituted as the Central American Mission, was founded by C. I. Scofield in 1890 as a non-denominational, evangelical, North American, missionary sending agency. Today, CAM has 250 missionaries serving in 10 countries including those of Central America, Mexico, the United States, Spain and Albania.

Since 1998, we have enjoyed partnering with Front Line Ministries (FLM) to provide training and care for our missionary family. Working with FLM is attractive and beneficial because of their professional competency, servant attitude, and commitment to Biblical values. FLM has served CAM well, especially during the days while we were in a care vacuum, before establishing a Member Care Department of our own.
